KEY LEADER

What you need for a Key Leader weekend!

* Check the weather of the camp location to determine how warm to dress.

Shoes

Closed-toe shoes such as sneakers or tennis shoes.

Flip flops are okay, but only for the shower.

No slip-on shoes are allowed on the ropes course.

(Example: TOMs shoes, etc).

Clothing

Comfortable clothes - jeans/sweatpants/shorts, T-shirts, long sleeved shirt, hoodies or a light jacket.

Appropriate sleep wear.

Raingear - rain slicker or umbrella

Cold weather gear - gloves or mittens and a hat.

* Most cabins do not provide bedding.

Bedding

Sleeping bag

Pillow

Blanket

* Bring whatever works best for you.

Linens

Towel and wash cloth (for shower)
(An old towel or beach towel is best.)

Toiletries

Toothbrush

Toothpaste

Shampoo

Soap

Deodorant

Food and beverages

Most camps do not allow food or beverages in the cabins. Do not bring food or drinks with you.

We will provide plenty of great meals and snacks throughout the weekend. If you require special meals/snacks, do not hesitate to let us know so that we can see to your needs.

Electronics

Do not bring expensive items with you to Key Leader, such as iPod, iPad, Kindle, Nook, or cash.

Other needed items

All forms sent to you by email, signed by a parent. All medications needed for the weekend.

Medication
